There will be a timetable set up for each class to go and have a look/purchase books. Alternatively books can be purchased after school.



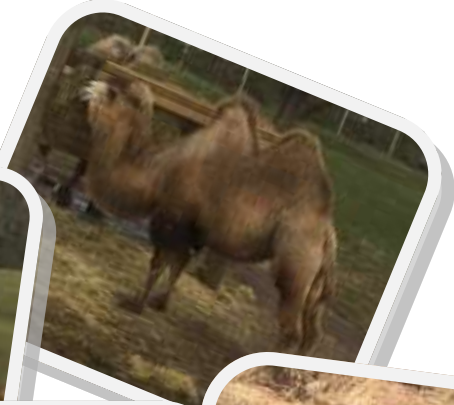
'Look – The Art of Seeing'

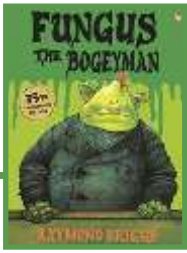




Book of The Week
