Dear Parents and Carers

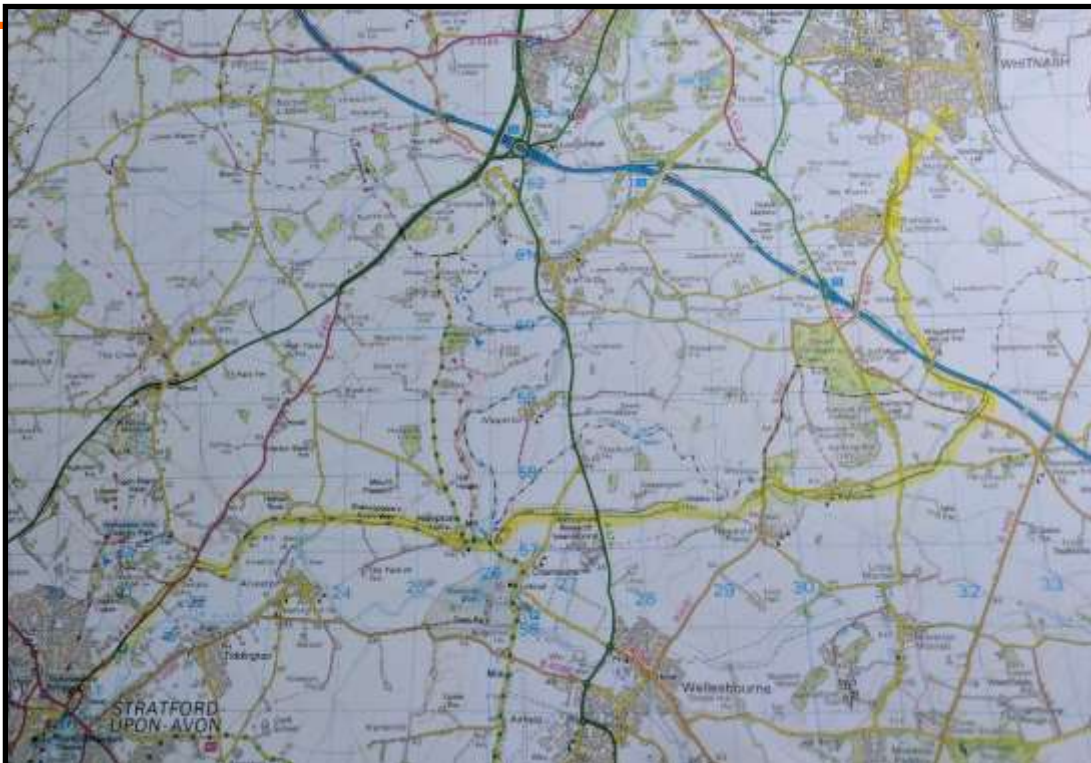
