









Year 2 homework menu A (Spring 1) Topic Question : What changed because of the Titanic

<p><u>Topic/Art</u> The Titanic was a passenger liner. Draw a picture of different type of boat, like a yacht, sail boat or house boat. See if you can use your pencil to shade the details.</p> 	<p><u>Maths</u>  A zoo has 4 tigers and 3 lions. How many legs are there altogether? Use an array (dots in lines)</p>	<p><u>Topic/Art</u> Create/build a model of a cruise liner (like the Titanic) with funnels and different levels. Use any material, e.g. lego, recycling, playdough etc.</p> 	<p><u>Science/PE</u> Plan an exercise regime for yourself that gets your heart beating. Use 10, 9, 8 etc. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10 star jumps • 9 touch your toes • 8 knee raises • 7 bunny hops etc <p>Write the plan in your book.</p>
<p><u>Science</u> Keep a food diary for a week. (Record your meals). Are you eating 5 fruit and vegetables a day?</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> The Titanic sailed from Southampton to New York. Can you find these in an atlas and draw map the route? What ocean did it cross?</p>	<p><u>Maths:</u> Make a poster to help you remember one of these times tables 2x 5x 3x or 10x</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Draw a map of your garden or the local park. Include what you would see there. Can you describe where things are using North, South, East and West?</p>
<p><u>Reading/English</u> Write a character description for a tiny mouse. Make up his name, what he is like (personality) and what he looks like.</p> 	<p><u>Art/Maths</u> Using a vegetable (like a potato) make at least 2 different 'stamps'. Using paint, dip them in and make a repeating pattern. -+ -+ -+ -+ -+ -+</p>	<p><u>Computing/Science</u> Use a computer program to make a poster about healthy eating. Include pictures, words and bullet points if you can.</p> 	<p><u>English</u> Write a letter to Year 2 pretending you are on board the Titanic having a lovely time. Tell them all the things you have done.</p>
<p><u>Maths</u> You have 24 apples. Share 24 apples into as many different equal groups as possible. Can you find all 8 ways?</p> 	<p><u>PSHE</u> Make up 10 questions for your family to get to know them better. You could ask things like, what is your favourite colour, where were you born, etc. Ask at least 2 people and compare the answers. Are they the same?</p>	<p><u>English</u> Describe your favourite meal. Use all your senses and describe What it looks like, smells like, tastes like and feels like. You might want to include the sound of it cooking too.</p>	<p><u>English - Ship dictionary</u> Ships have different parts. Can you find out the meaning of these words? Draw or write your findings. Stern, bow, deck, anchor, and hull. <i>Are there any others you found out?</i></p>
